WHO WE ARE

We are a UK charity, established in 2017, and dedicated to inspiring and equipping Christians to:

Reach older people with the Gospel

Disciple them as followers of Jesus

Mobilise them in God's mission



Together with our partner charities Pilgrims' Friend Society, The Salvation Army, Keychange, and London City Mission we are experienced in the pastoral and missional needs churches face.

This, alongside the expertise of our grassroots ambassadors, enables us to serve a network of over 1000 seniors workers and church leaders. We call these 'Church Champions' as they champion the cause of older people through the local church.

We are members of the Evangelical Alliance and subscribe to their Basis of Faith.

WHY IT MATTERS

The population in the UK is ageing fast. This represents both challenges and opportunities for the gospel and for the church.

The Bible is clear; God chose us before the foundations of the earth, He loves and values us for the whole of our lives. He wants none to perish, and He has made a way for everyone to receive His forgiveness, His friendship, and the eternal life only He can offer.

But ministry among older people can be complicated, it's often underresourced, and it can feel like a lonely ministry sometimes.

WHAT WE DO

We inspire and equip you to reach, disciple and mobilise older people through the church by providing:

- Networking events for people in similar roles
- Expert-led webinars on key issues
- Support for church leaders and teams
- Signposting to helpful resources
- In person talks and seminars at conferences
- A lively WhatsApp group for prayer, support, and ideas
- Inspirational blogs and videos

We raise awareness of later life issues such as ageism, loneliness, dementia, how to share the gospel with older people, and the importance of retiring well.

We regularly feature in the media including BBC Radio, Premier Christian Radio, UCB and God TV, and we are blessed with generous supporters across the faith and later life sectors who help us reach the UK with our message.

We also provide **DailyHOPE**, a dial in service that operates 24 hours a day, seven days a week. This is a lifeline to older people who can no longer attend church and who are offline.
